.1. Description of first aid measures		
First-aid measures general : Call a poison center or a doctor if you feel unwell.		
First-aid measures after inhalation	: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. If experiencing respiratory symptoms, call a doctor.	
First-aid measures after skin contact	<ul> <li>Do not pull bonded skin apart. Use a blunt object such as a spoon to gently release the bonded skin. Soaking in warm soapy water will aid with the debonding. Gently wash with plenty of soap and water. Cyanoacrylates give off heat on solidification. In rare cases a large drop will generate enough heat to cause a burn. Burns should be treated normally after the adhesive has been removed from the skin.</li> <li>If lips are accidentally stuck together apply warm water to the lips and encourage maximum wetting and pressure from saliva inside the mouth. Peel or roll lips apart. Do not try to pull the lips apart with direct opposing action. If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice/attention.</li> </ul>	
First-aid measures after eye contact	: Immediately flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention. If eyelids are bonded closed, release eyelashes with warm water by covering with a wet pad. Do not force eye open. Cyanoacrylate will bond to eye protein and will cause a lachrymatory effect which will help to debond the adhesive. Keep eye covered until debonding is complete, usually within 1-3 days. Medical attention should be sought in case solid particles of polymerized cyanoacrylate trapped behind the eyelid caused abrasive damage.	
First-aid measures after ingestion	: Adhesive becomes solid in contact with saliva and may adhere to inside of mouth. Saliva will lift adhesive in 1-2 days. Avoid swallowing solid adhesive after detachment.
